

Regional Alternative School

Single Credit and Virtual High School Program

This program is designed to assist students who need additional credits to graduate from High School. It is specifically for those students who need one or two courses per semester to maintain their Junior or Senior status. Each section is limited to approximately 12 students that allows for individualized access to computers and Internet programs. Students must be in grades 11th or 12th and currently enrolled in their Home School District.

Registration: Students must register in person at the Regional Alternative School site, 408 W Washington Street, Bloomington.

Cost: There will be a \$25.00 registration fee that will be collected with the initial referral. This expense will cover any on-line tuition costs and any instructional materials provided by the instructor.

Procedures and Expectations: All students are expected to act responsibly and courteously, come to class on time, complete all assignments and adhere to all the rules and expectations as outlined in the Alternative School handbook. Participation in this evening program is a privilege and will be revoked if a student fails to cooperate or interferes with the education of other students.

Student will not be permitted to attend class until all fees are paid and the referral form is completed with all the proper signatures from their Home School.

Attendance: Students must have a specific number of direct contact hours with a teacher to receive high school credit for the course. A student who has more than **4 absences**, for any reason (**there are no excuse absences**), may be withdrawn from the program.

Academic Credit: Students will receive ½ academic credit per semester for each course successfully completed. Final grades will be forwarded to the Home School. The decision to award academic credit for a specific course will be at the discretion of the Home School
